MvP: Management Visit Program Workshop Overview

- Ensure everyone is left in action both management and at worksite;
- Learn how to monitor and measure the effectiveness of management site visits by the value of the actions taken;
- Learn how to better plan and follow through on management site visits;
- Establish an effective single line of sight so that both management and workers alike are focused on the same, underlying issues and challenges;
- Maximize improvement opportunities;
- Recognize and celebrate breakthroughs and successes.
